8. He drinks milk every morning. (milk – common noun, material noun)
9. I am going to the cinema tonight. (cinema – common noun)
10. The lion is the king of beasts. (lion, king, beasts – common noun)
11. A spider has eight legs. (spider – common noun; legs – common noun)
12. Julia wants to be a writer. (Julia – proper noun; writer – common noun)
