Make sentences in the present continuous tense.

We make present continuous tense forms by putting **is**, **am** or **are** before the -ing form of the verb.

Use **'is'** when the subject is a singular noun (cat, boy, teacher) or singular pronoun (he, she, it).

Use **'are'** when the subject is a plural noun (cats, girls, teachers) or plural pronoun (they, we, you).

Use **'am'** when the subject is the first person singular pronoun **I**.

1. I ----- Oliver Twist. (read)
2. He ----- with us. (not come)
3. The girls ----- a song. (sing)
4. The child ----- (cry)
5. Why ----- she -----? (cry)
6. I ----- letters. (write)
7. Dad ----- the car. (repair)

11. I ----- your dad tomorrow. (see)
12. We ----- on a holiday next week. (go)
